3) Read pages 500-507 in you textbook. Take any notes from your reading you think necessary to the understanding of these pages. What would like to be able to use on a quiz! 35 points
4) Read Chapter 1 in your textbook. Using a spiral notebook, define vocabulary words p. 40-41. You do not need to write out long definitions just what you need to understand the terms. You do not need to take notes over this chapter. 40 points

## SUMMER ASSIGNMENT <br> Article Reviews

## 50 points

Current events enhance classroom discussions. Over the summer break you will need to read the newspaper, magazines, internet sources (cnn.com for example) for current events. You are expected to compile 5 articles with 5 summary reviews. It is difficult to require a specific length for the articles because sometimes very powerful, evocative messages come in abbreviated form. A newspaper article may be short column but contain all that you need to summarize and comment on the topic.

Look for articles that interest you and can further discussions and debates. A copy of each article must be stapled to the summary and compiled in a folder. Write or type at least 2 paragraphs (at least 5 sentence paragraphs) for each article. The first paragraph is the article is the summary, the second can be your opinions, concerns, or future predictions.

Your articles need to each relate to a different country or area of the world AND each must represent a different topic from the following list:

1) population and/or migration
2) pop culture-this relates to entertainment and sports
3) religion and/or language
4) ethnicity and /or ethnic problem
5) politics and how it relates to geography
6) economics and how it relates to geography
7) agriculture
8) service and industry
9) urbanization
10) architecture
