TITLE 1 PARENT INVOLVEMENT POLICY MONTGOMERY CENTRAL ELEMENTARY SCHOOL

The parents and staff of Montgomery Central Elementary School believe the Title 1 program in our school can be most successful if parents and school staff form a true partnership for the purpose of providing high quality education for all students.

- 1. Parental involvement in the development, implementation, and evaluation of a school-level parent involvement policy.
 - a. The Title 1 planning team, composed of staff and parents, will develop a parent involvement policy, including a compact for Montgomery Central Elementary School to be distributed to parents no later than the end of the first nine- week grading period.
 - b. At the annual Title 1 meetings, all parents of Title 1 students will be given a copy of the school-wide and system-wide parent involvement policies, and be given the opportunity to review these policies and suggest changes. Changes to the policy will be made by vote of the majority, but all suggestions will be recorded in the minutes of the meeting.
- 2. Parents will receive support from Montgomery Central Elementary School in becoming full partners in their child's education. This support will include the following:
 - a. An annual meeting will be held for the purpose of explaining the Title 1 program, as well as giving parents an opportunity to review the program and suggest changes.
 - b. Parents will be provided with written progress reports of their child's academic performance every three weeks.
 - c. One parent teacher conference day will be scheduled each year with the opportunity for parents to schedule multiple conferences throughout the year as needed.
 - d. Parents will receive timely information about the Title 1 program through MCES's monthly newsletter, the Learning Center monthly newsletter, personal notes, e-mails, and phone calls.
 - e. Workshops for parents over a variety of topics will be held at the Learning Centers.
 - f. Child care will be provided during parent workshops to enable parents the opportunity to participate.
 - g. The Learning Centers will host an Open House each year to share with parents the many resources they have to offer.
